

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) Use Cases | gGastro MMGI

gGastro supports multi-factor authentication (MFA) using industry standards in alignment with the Office of the National Coordinator for Health IT's (ONC) Multi-factor authentication criterion at 45 C.F.R. §170.315(d)(13) for web browser user login and EPCS.

For login, the application provides an MFA solution that requires using a third-party application, such as Google Authenticator. There are no additional fees for this feature.

For EPCS, we use the supported MFA by our 3rd party integration with DrFirst through their EPCS Gold platform. There are no additional fees for MFA, however; there is a charge for the use and activation of the EPCS feature.
